Discussion Questions

1. What does Maren believe magick will solve for her at the beginning of the story?
2. How does grief influence Maren's decision to cast the love spell?
3. Do you view the spell as a mistake, a rite of passage, or an act of desperation?
4. The *Knight of Pentacles* appears as a symbol. What does he represent: destiny, escape, or possibility?
5. How does Maren's secrecy (with family and friends) deepen the consequences of the spell?
6. Where do you see the first moment Maren realizes she cannot control what she summoned?
7. How does this story deepen your understanding of her choices later in her life in *The Wheel of the Year Mysteries*?
8. If you could give Maren one piece of advice at this age, what would it be?

Signature Mocktail — The Witch Fire Ember Elixir

Vibe: Warm, glowing, and a little dangerous — like candlelight meeting first love.

Ingredients (per drink):

- 4 oz sparkling blood orange soda (or sparkling water + splash of juice)
- 1 oz pomegranate juice
- ½ oz cinnamon simple syrup (honey + cinnamon simmered and cooled)
- Fresh orange slice
- Optional: dried rose petals or edible glitter for garnish

Instructions:

1. Add pomegranate juice and cinnamon syrup to a glass with ice.
2. Top with sparkling blood orange soda.
3. Stir gently.
4. Garnish with an orange slice and sprinkle rose petals for dramatic witch vibes.

Mocktail intention: Sip slowly, think of what you're calling in — and what you're willing to release.
